Anthony Lister was born in Brisbane in 1980, and completed a Bachelor of Fine Arts at Queensland College of the Arts, Brisbane. He was mentored by Max Gimblett in New York in 2002 and was the recipient of the 2004 Education Queensland Minister's Art Awards, with a further mentoring workshop residency at Blender Studio, Melbourne.

Lister currently lives in New York with a studio in Brooklyn. In 2007 he has an impressive international line-up of group shows in London, Seattle and L.A.

In January 2007, he was involved in a project to paint on a derelict building in Manhattan and this work featured on the cover of the New York Times Art Section.

Through an exploration of the figure, tattooing, graffiti and the urbanscape, Lister reflects on the world around him and how it changes him.
