Pasquale "Paski" Giardino was a founding member of the Roar group of artists. He has a distinct and vibrant style, and his work reflects suburban pop culture, frequently accesses diverse media such as collage with a simplistic almost childlike approach.

His work is busy, impatient, colourful, naïve and intuitive with a brilliant dash of humour. Giardino has a well honed gift of observation of the banal and the everyday, married with an insatiable interest in ancient mythology, which brings his paintings to life.

In a blaze of vibrant colour and bold shapes, his artwork tell stories that are animated, humorous, chaotic and sometimes menacing, but which are always engaging.

Still well under priced for a major artist from the Roar group - Pasquale's only recent rediscovery means expected high returns for early investors in his works - particularly for original pieces.
